(a) to (c): The Ministry of Tourism under its scheme of Swadesh Darshan and National Mission on Pilgrimage Rejuvenation and Spiritual, Heritage Augmentation Drive (PRASHAD) provides financial Assistance to the State Governments/ Union Territory Administrations/ Central Agencies for development of tourism infrastructure and facilities in the country including in the state of Odisha. The projects under the schemes are identified for development in consultation with the State Governments/ Union Territory Administrations and are sanctioned subject to availability of funds, submission of suitable Detailed Project Reports, adherence to scheme guidelines and utilization of funds released earlier.

The details of the projects sanctioned under Swadesh Darshan scheme which cover components such as wayside facilities, toilets & sanity components are annexed.
