Unsigned CVs shall be rejected; All forms are submitted in the prescribed formats and signed by the prescribed signatories.	It is clarified that all the documents uploaded by the bidder should be signed/countersigned by the authorized signatory.
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2. It may also be noted that the Proposal Due Date (PDD) is extended till 24th May, 2021 (Monday). The bids will be opened on the 25th May, 2021 or the next convenient working day after the lockdown.
