Indian National Departures May, 2022

Ministry of Tourism compiles monthly Indian National Departures (INDs) 2022 (Provisional) on the basis of information received from Bureau of Immigration (BOI).

The following are the important highlights regarding Destination wise Indian National Departures (INDs) Provisional during the month of May, 2022:

Indian Nationals Departures (INDs):

- INDs in May 2022 were 19,02,565 as compared to 1,54,873 in May 2021 and 23,84,815 in May 2019 registering a growth of 1128.5% and -20.2% with respect to 2021 and 2019 respectively.
- INDs during the period January- May, 2022 were 72,23,923 as compared to 28,40,983 in January- May, 2021 and 11181497 in Jan-May 2019 registering a growth of 154.3% and -35.4% with respect to 2021 and 2019 respectively.
- The percentage share of Destination wise Indian National Departures from India during May 2022 among the top 15 destination countries was highest from UAE (27.06%) followed by Saudi Arabia (10.72%), USA (9.64%), Singapore (4.59%), Canada (4.34%), Thailand (3.93%), UK (3.88%), Qatar (3.74%), Kuwait (3.59%), Oman (3.27%), Australia (2.74%), Bangladesh (2.37%), Maldives (1.78%), Bahrain (1.67%) and Malaysia (1.40%).
- The percentage share of Destination wise Indian National Departures from India during January-May 2022 among the top 15 destination countries were highest from UAE (31.24%) followed by Saudi Arabia (11.90%), USA (8.89%), Qatar (4.68%), Kuwait (4.20%), Canada (4.08%), UK (4.01%), Oman (3.83%), Singapore (3.80%), Australia (2.32%), Bangladesh (1.88%), Bahrain (1.85%), Thailand (1.66%), Maldives (1.63%) and Germany (1.21%).
