Foreign Tourist Inflow to India May, 2022

Ministry of Tourism compiles monthly Foreign Tourist Arrivals (FTAs) on the basis of information received from Bureau of Immigration (BOI). The following are the important highlights regarding FTAs during the month of May, 2022.

Foreign Tourist Arrivals (FTAs):

- FTAs in May, 2022 were 4,23,701 with a positive growth rate of 2043.7% as compared to 19,765 in May, 2021.
- FTAs during the period January- May, 2022 were 16,01,381 as compared to 4,37,225 in May, 2021 registering a positive growth of 266.3%.
- The percentage share of Foreign Tourist Arrivals in India during May 2022 among the top 15 source countries was highest from USA (27.80%) followed by Bangladesh (23.47%), UK (7.58%), Australia (4.02%), Canada (3.65%), Sri Lanka (2.84%), Singapore (2.36%), Nepal (2.12%), Malaysia (1.66%), Germany (1.65%), France (1.47%), Maldives (1.26%), Portugal (1.13%), Oman (1.13%) and Korea (Rep of) (0.85%).
- The percentage share of Foreign Tourist Arrivals in India during January-May 2022 among the top 15 source countries was highest from USA (25.57%) followed by Bangladesh (15.86%), UK (11.65%), Australia (6.10%), Canada (5.70%), Sri Lanka (3.74%), Nepal (2.57%), Germany (1.82%), Singapore (1.72%), France (1.58%), Portugal (1.54%), Maldives (1.28%), Russian Federation (1.16%), Malaysia (1.03%) & Italy (0.86)
- The percentage share of Foreign Tourist Arrivals in India during May 2022 among the top 15 ports was highest at Delhi Airport (25.90%) followed by Mumbai Airport (14.09%), Haridaspur Land Check Post (12.27%), Chennai Airport (10.30%), Bengaluru Airport (7.55%), Hyderabad Airport (6.09%), Cochin Airport (4.96%), Kolkata Airport (4.22%), Ahmedabad Airport (2.43%), Agartala Airport (1.92%), Trivandrum Airport (1.61%), Ghojadanga Airport (1.46%), Tiruchirappalli Airport (1.16%), Changrabandha LandCheckpost (1.15%) and Amritsar Airport (0.92%).
- The percentage share of Foreign Tourist Arrivals in India during January-May 2022 among the top 15 ports was highest at Delhi Airport (35.50%) followed by Mumbai Airport (14.58%), Chennai Airport (9.92%), Haridaspur Land Check

Post (7.00%), Bengaluru Airport (6.06%), Hyderabad Airport (5.14%), Cochin Airport (4.71%), Kolkata Airport (4.42%), Ahmedabad Airport (3.45%), Trivandrum Airport (1.43%), Dabolim (Goa) Airport (1.21%), Agartala Airport (1.15%), Amritsar Airport (0.98%), Tiruchirappalli Airport (0.85%) and Gede Land Check Post (0.67%).
