
Indian National Departures July, 2022

Ministry of Tourism compiles monthly Indian National Departures (INDs) 2022 (Provisional) on the basis of information received from Bureau of Immigration (BOI).

The following are the important highlights regarding Destination wise Indian National Departures (INDs) Provisional during the month of July, 2022:

Indian Nationals Departures (INDs):

- INDs in July 2022 were 17,93,684 as compared to 2,23,956 in July 2021 and 21,80,437 in July 2019 registering a growth of 700.9% and -17.7% with respect to 2021 and 2019 respectively.
- INDs during the period January- July, 2022 were 10,886,586 as compared to 32,15,656 in January- July, 2021 and 15,560,516 in January-July 2019 registering a growth of 238.5% and -40.7% with respect to 2021 and 2019 respectively.
- The percentage share of Destination wise Indian National Departures from India during July, 2022 among the top 15 destination countries was highest for UAE (24.15%) followed by Saudi Arabia (10.01%), USA (9.20), Singapore (5.85%), Thailand (5.59%), Kuwait (4.79%), UK (4.46%), Oman (4.27%), Qatar (4.22%), Canada (3.07%), Bangladesh (2.49%), Australia (2.17%), Malaysia (2.07%), Bahrain (1.49%) and Maldives (1.16%).
- The percentage share of Destination wise Indian National Departures from India during January-July, 2022 among the top 15 destination countries were highest for UAE (28.80%) followed by Saudi Arabia (11.61%), USA (8.98%), Singapore (4.46%), Qatar (4.37%), Kuwait (4.28%), UK (4.14%), Canada (3.88%), Oman (3.76%), Thailand (3.01%), Australia (2.29%), Bangladesh (2.10%), Bahrain (1.73%), Maldives (1.52%) and Germany (1.17%).
