
Foreign Tourist Inflow to India July, 2022

Ministry of Tourism compiles monthly Foreign Tourist Arrivals (FTAs) on the basis of information received from Bureau of Immigration (BOI). The following are the important highlights regarding FTAs during the month of July, 2022.

Foreign Tourist Arrivals (FTAs):

- FTAs in July, 2022 were 6,40,858 as compared to 72,501 in July, 2021 and 8,18,125 in July, 2019 registering a growth of 783.9% and -21.7% with respect to 2021 and 2019 respectively.
- FTAs during the period January- July, 2022 were 27,64,975 as compared to 5,45,796 in January-July, 2021 and 61,14,150 in January-July, 2019 registering a growth of 406.6% and -54.8% with respect to 2021 and 2019 respectively.
- The percentage share of Foreign Tourist Arrivals in India during July, 2022 among the top 15 source countries was highest from Bangladesh (23.55%), followed by USA (21.33%), UK (13.24%), Canada (3.28%), Australia (3.17%), Sri Lanka (2.60%), France (2.37%), Nepal (2.08%), Maldives (2.07%), Germany (1.80%), Malaysia (1.80%), UAE (1.38%), Singapore (1.33%), Oman (1.29%) and Portugal (1.15%).
- The percentage share of Foreign Tourist Arrivals in India during January- July, 2022 among the top 15 source countries was highest from USA (25.88%), followed by Bangladesh (18.61%), UK (10.99%), Australia (5.16), Canada (4.63%), Sri Lanka (3.31%), Nepal (2.31%), France (1.78%), Germany (1.73%), Singapore (1.71%), Maldives (1.46%), Malaysia (1.37%), Portugal (1.36%), Oman (1.02%), Russian Federation (0.91%) & Italy (0.84%).
- The percentage share of Foreign Tourist Arrivals in India during July 2022 among the top 15 ports was highest at Delhi Airport (26.40%) followed by Mumbai Airport (12.74%), Haridaspur Land Check Post (11.98%), Chennai Airport (10.72%), Bengaluru Airport (7.42%), Hyderabad Airport (5.87%), Cochin Airport (5.78%), Kolkata Airport (3.40%), Ahmedabad Airport (2.14%), Ghojadanga Land Check Post (1.94%), Agartala Land Check Post (1.79%), Trivandrum Airport (1.70%), Changrabandha Land Check Post (1.43%), and Tiruchirappalli Airport (1.05%).

• The percentage share of Foreign Tourist Arrivals in India during January-July 2022 among the top 15 ports was highest at Delhi Airport (31.66%) followed by Mumbai Airport (13.92%), Chennai Airport (10.41%), Haridaspur Land Check Post (8.82%), Bengaluru Airport (6.70%), Hyderabad Airport (5.68%), Cochin Airport (5.04%), Kolkata Airport (4.01%), Ahmedabad Airport (2.90%), Trivandrum Airport (1.54%), Agartala Land Check Post (1.32%), Amritsar Airport (0.87%), Dabolim (Goa) Airport (0.84%), Ghojadanga Land Check Post (0.75%), and Tiruchirappalli Airport (0.74%).
