Foreign Tourist Inflow to India June, 2022

Ministry of Tourism compiles monthly Foreign Tourist Arrivals (FTAs) on the basis of information received from Bureau of Immigration (BOI). The following are the important highlights regarding FTAs during the month of June, 2022.

Foreign Tourist Arrivals (FTAs):

- FTAs in June, 2022 were 5,22,737 as compared to 36,070 in June, 2021 and 7,26,446 in June 2019 registering a growth of 1349.2% and -28.0% with respect to 2022 and 2019 respectively.
- FTAs during the period January- June, 2022 were 21,24,118 as compared to 4,73,295 in January-June, 2021 and 52,96,025 in January-June, 2019 registering a growth of 348.8% and -59.9% with respect to 2022 and 2019 respectively.
- The percentage share of Foreign Tourist Arrivals in India during June 2022 among the top 15 source countries was highest from USA (32.42%) followed by Bangladesh (21.00%), UK (6.21%), Australia (4.73%), Canada (3.02%), Sri Lanka (2.86%), Singapore (2.16%), Malaysia (1.90%), Nepal (1.79%), France (1.68%), Germany (1.34%), Oman (1.26%), Maldives (1.23%), Portugal (1.06%) and Ireland (0.98%).
- The percentage share of Foreign Tourist Arrivals in India during January- June 2022 among the top 15 source countries was highest from USA (19.28%) followed by Bangladesh (17.12%), UK (10.31%), Australia (5.76%), Canada (5.04%), Sri Lanka (3.52%), Nepal (2.37%), Singapore (1.83%), Germany (1.70%), France (1.61%), Portugal (1.42%), Maldives (1.27%), Malaysia (1.25%), Russian Federation (0.99%) & Oman (0.94%).
- The percentage share of Foreign Tourist Arrivals in India during June 2022 among the top 15 ports was highest at Delhi Airport (26.36%) followed by Mumbai Airport (13.35%), Chennai Airport (11.52%), Haridaspur Land Check post (10.53%), Bangalore Airport (7.79%), Hyderabad Airport (7.10%), Cochin Airport (5.16%), Kolkata Airport (3.49%), Ahmedabad Airport (2.13%), Ghojadanga Land Checkpost (1.99%), Trivandrum Airport (1.70%), Tiruchirapalli Airport (1.44%), Agartala Land Checkpost (1.26%), Changrabandha Land Checkpost (1.02%) and Chitpur Rail Chekpost (0.94%).

• The percentage share of Foreign Tourist Arrivals in India during January-June 2022 among the top 15 ports was highest at Delhi Airport (33.25%) followed by Mumbai Airport (14.28%), Chennai Airport (10.31%), Haridaspur Land Check Post (7.87%), Bengaluru Airport (6.48%), Hyderabad Airport (5.62%), Cochin Airport (4.82%), Kolkata Airport (4.19%), Ahmedabad Airport (3.12%), Trivandrum Airport (1.49%), Agartala Land Check Post (1.18%), Dabolim (Goa) Airport (0.91%), Amritsar Airport (0.90%), Tiruchirappalli Airport (0.64%), and Gede Road Land Checkpost (0.57%).
