Indian National Departures August, 2022

Ministry of Tourism compiles monthly Indian National Departures (INDs) 2022 (Provisional) on the basis of information received from Bureau of Immigration (BOI).

The following are the important highlights regarding Destination wise Indian National Departures (INDs) Provisional during the month of August, 2022:

Indian Nationals Departures (INDs):

- INDs in August 2022 were 21,25,529 as compared to 6,61188 in August 2021 and 23,51,701 in August 2019 registering a growth of 221.5% and -9.6% with respect to 2021 and 2019 respectively.
- INDs during the period January- August, 2022 were 13,012,115 as compared to 38,76,844 in January- August, 2021 and 17,912,217 in January-August 2019 registering a growth of 235.6% and -27.4% with respect to 2021 and 2019 respectively.
- The percentage share of Destination wise Indian National Departures from India during August, 2022 among the top 15 destination countries was highest for UAE (27.00%) followed by Saudi Arabia (11.58%), USA (9.44), Thailand (5.12%), Qatar (4.71%), Kuwait (4.47%), Singapore (4.46%), UK (3.61%), Oman (3.55%), Canada (3.38%), Australia (2.22%), Bahrain (1.79%) Malaysia (1.79%), Bangladesh (1.75%) and Maldives (1.06%).
- The percentage share of Destination wise Indian National Departures from India during January-August, 2022 among the top 15 destination countries were highest for UAE (28.51%) followed by Saudi Arabia (11.60%), USA (9.06%), Singapore (4.46%), Qatar (4.43%), Kuwait (4.31%), UK (4.05%), Canada (3.80%), Oman (3.72%), Thailand (3.36%), Australia (2.28%), Bangladesh (2.04%), Bahrain (1.74%), Maldives (1.44%) and Malaysia (1.25%).
