
Indian National Departures November, 2022

Ministry of Tourism compiles monthly Indian National Departures (INDs) 2022 (Provisional) on the basis of information received from Bureau of Immigration (BOI).

The following are the important highlights regarding Destination wise Indian National Departures (INDs) Provisional during the month of November, 2022:

Indian Nationals Departures (INDs):

- INDs in November 2022 were 18,76,096 as compared to 11,88,345 in November 2021 and 21,47,330 in November 2019 registering a growth of 57.9 % and -12.6% with respect to 2021 and 2019 respectively.
- INDs during the period January- November, 2022 were 1,89,71,501 as compared to 71,23,472 in January-November, 2021 and 2,45,59,057 in January-November 2019 registering a growth of 166.3% and -22.8% with respect to 2021 and 2019 respectively.
- The percentage share of Destination wise Indian National Departures from India during November, 2022 among the top 15 destination countries was highest for UAE (27.87%) followed by Saudi Arabia (10.72%), Thailand (7.05%), USA (5.69%), Singapore (4.99%), UK (3.85%), Qatar (3.71%), Kuwait (3.16%), Oman (2.94%), Australia (2.68%), Canada (2.60%), Bangladesh (2.40%), Malaysia (1.92%), Maldives (1.29%) and Bahrain (1.25%).
- The percentage share of Destination wise Indian National Departures from India during January-November, 2022 among the top 15 destination countries were highest for UAE (28.05%) followed by Saudi Arabia (11.53%), USA (8.09%), Singapore (4.62%), UK (4.44%), Qatar (4.23%), Thailand (4.18%), Kuwait (4.07%), Canada (3.53%), Oman (3.47%), Australia (2.24%), Bangladesh (2.11%), Bahrain (1.61%), Malaysia (1.45%) and Maldives (1.36%).
