
Indian National Departures September, 2022

Ministry of Tourism compiles monthly Indian National Departures (INDs) 2022 (Provisional) on the basis of information received from Bureau of Immigration (BOI).

The following are the important highlights regarding Destination wise Indian National Departures (INDs) Provisional during the month of September, 2022:

Indian Nationals Departures (INDs):

- INDs in September, 2022 were 21,36,212 as compared to 9,62,026 in September, 2021 and 23,54,445 in September, 2019 registering a growth of 122.1% and -9.3% with respect to 2021 and 2019 respectively.
- INDs during the period January-September, 2022 were 1,51,48,327 as compared to 48,38,870 in January-September, 2021 and 2,02,66,662 in January-September 2019 registering a growth of 213.1% and -25.3% with respect to 2021 and 2019 respectively.
- The percentage share of Destination wise Indian National Departures from India during September, 2022 among the top 15 destination countries was highest for UAE (25.31%) followed by Saudi Arabia (12.08%), UK (6.96%), USA (6.56%), Thailand (5.06%), Singapore (4.78%), Kuwait (3.94%), Qatar (3.82%), Canada (3.45%), Oman (2.83%), Bangladesh (1.92%) Australia (1.81%), Malaysia (1.76%), Bahrain (1.55%) and Germany (1.41%).
- The percentage share of Destination wise Indian National Departures from India during January-September, 2022 among the top 15 destination countries were highest for UAE (28.06%) followed by Saudi Arabia (11.67%), USA (8.70%), Singapore (4.50%), UK (4.46%), Qatar (4.34%), Kuwait (4.26%), Canada (3.75%), Oman (3.60%), Thailand (3.60%), Australia (2.21%), Bangladesh (2.02%), Bahrain (1.71%), Maldives (1.38%) and Malaysia (1.32%).
